**January 15, 2008 Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. There were 19 in attendance. Regrets from Chris Dewar and Jess Leung.

The meeting agenda was approved.

**Acceptance of Previous Minutes**

Correction to September 18, 2007 minutes: Luxton 75<sup>th</sup> should read Luxton 100<sup>th</sup>.  
Motion: by Bill Sutherland, seconded by Alan Freedman, to accept the minutes as revised. Carried.

**Treasurer's Report**

Current Balance: \$2,837.10; \$1,300 is designated for the Alumni Wall, \$200 for the Techonian, leaving a working balance of \$1,337.10.

**Committee Reports**

Finance: Jess Leung will prepare a budget template that will be forwarded to all chairs.  
Budgets and supply lists are due by March 31, 2008.

Souvenirs: Johnny Olynyk is pricing both items to sell and giveaway. It was suggested that no souvenirs be sold until at least next year.

Friday: Alan Freedman has a commitment from Ray Wheeler to be the music man on June 18, 2010.

Web: Yuri Korchyński has the new site up and running but it needs more content. boomdonenext.com will look into donating server space. There are 628 records in the on-line database; some of these are duplicates and need editing.

Alumni Wall: Susan Gibb announced the two display cases are up on the walls across from the junior gym. Supplies have been ordered for the next section. The title above the wall will read "St. John's Centennial Alumni Wall". There are still some t-shirts for sale.

Advertising/Promotions: an interview will be arranged with Jeremy Valance from Shaw TV to promote Alumni Wall. Suzie and Marni will write "letters to the editors" of various papers to promote reunion.

Executive: The Exec has met twice since the last meeting; with the Day Chairs on October 26 to revise the 2010 weekend activities, and with Yuri on November 15 to discuss the web site. The school has included a reference to the anniversary on its letterhead. Mr. Bridgeford-Read, one of the art teachers, plans to create a

new mural for the main entrance this year featuring the 100<sup>th</sup>. He hopes alumni will get involved.

An article by Myron Love about the 100<sup>th</sup> and the Alumni Wall will appear in the *Jewish Post* newspaper. Notices about the meeting and social were placed in Judy Wasylycia Leis' December constituents' newsletter.

- Johnny Olynyk brought information about the Nostalgia Broadcasting Cooperative. The Exec will look over.
- Marni Larkin provided copies of the anniversary letterhead and logo, designed by boomdonenext.
- Steps have been taken to legally register the name St. John's Alumni 2010 using a Name Notation. This designation will note the name of the committee on the Companies Office records for three years.
- The second annual alumni golf tournament is July 15 at Larters. Alan expects the cost to be the same as last year (\$125 for golf, cart, lunch and dinner). Committee volunteers are needed!
- The need for a chair to manage donations/solicitations was discussed. Carolyn Rickey will continue to oversee this area. All chairs are to include their requirements for products, services, etc. with their March 31 budgets. Carolyn and the exec will meet in April to coordinate the lists and find suppliers.
- March Social: March 20, 2008 at Garden City Inn main ballroom. Tickets: \$12. (420 for sale). Tickets were handed out and will be available through the school office. Posters and donation letters were also distributed and will be available from the web site. March 14 is the last day for selling tickets. Funds will be raised through an auction and break open envelope sales.
- Susan Gibb mentioned the idea of continuing a St. John's alumni committee after the 100<sup>th</sup>.
- A brass door trim from the old school is in the basement. If funds are available from the school division, the plaque would be cleaned and mounted over an inside door at the Church Avenue entrance.
