1. Call to Order.

Meeting called to order at 7:05 pm. 8 people were in attendance.

2. Approval of Agenda

5. Committee Reports/Activity Updates

- **Executive/Financial**

Carole K. informed that Kathy Youngston from the Luxton Anniversary committee will let us include a pamphlet/brochure or have a person will attend their function to take names down. Carole K will follow up.

Organization Committee – We have added a Patrons, Sponsor and Suppliers committee to the chart. Carolyn Rickey and Victoria Lehman will look after this committee.

Still looking for a Saturday Day Chair. John Silver and Gloria Kropla will put out emails stating that volunteers for specific days/duties are needed.

- **Audio Visual**

John Silver has the website up and running. We can start advertising for events. John Silver will send Gloria Kropla Excel spreadsheet to update names. John Silver will be putting different historical facts/audio etc on website. John will digitize music for website for different years.

- **Golf Tournament**

Alan Freedman not in attendance. Carole K. updates that a date has been confirmed **July 17th** at Larters Golf and 4 people have joined the committee. Alan Freedman is looking for someone to do mailers, take minutes, etc. at meetings. Alan would like to know where the money will go. The 8 in attendance decided that the money will go to the Anniversary Committee which will be turned over to the school if surplus.

- **Alumni Wall**
Sue Gibb reported that a few purchases and donations have been made. The website will be updated as to the list of people who have donated. There is more money needed to start construction.

- **Celebrating Athletics Banquet**
A date was originally set for April 20th. After some discussion it was decided that until we have a committee in place to completely run this event, the banquet will be put on hold until further notice (maybe in early October). Carole K will contact Morris Glimcher to brainstorm to find out who that committee might be. Carole K will cancel the permit set for April 20th. A few names were discussed as to who might be a strong candidate to run this event. Further discussion will take place next meeting.

6. **New Business**

Regarding Website – lists or pictures of interest to be forwarded to John Silver. Chris Dewar wants to find out about copyright rules for posting on web. Question was raised as to whether obituaries are something that should be on the web? John Silver says yes.

John Olinyk handed out copies of articles from newspapers – re: online ticket service, fingerprinting for 100th and articles from local newspaper. The committee will look into these and get back to John.

Sam Singer would like to know whether we will be having a parade? Will the Mayor be there? The Lieutenant Governor? Sam had some great ideas and John Silver suggested that he put everything in writing and present it to the committee.

It was discussed that St. John's High School has newsletters distributed every 2 months and we will start putting ads in the paper.

Arthur Liffman from Sals will be contacted to explore potential relationships with them. It was stated that we would like to incorporate Sals in various activities throughout these 4 years.

Diane Zack informed the table that she has bodies to help with the Techonian.

A discussion was held whether we should start meeting every 2 months for the General Meeting. The Executive can meet every other month as necessary. Those in attendance agreed that this would be a good idea for now.
